In 2010 Global demand for Transmission and Distribution equipment totaled over US\$130 billion with China's total coming in at just under 20% of that number.

NRG Expert forecasts that by 2015 the market will have grown by 33% thanks in large part to the replacement of old infrastructure and the increasing rollout of smarter grid technologies.
